- First major review since 2016
- Commissioned researchers to understand if qualifications regime needs to be reformed
- Review will cover
 - AO approval/accreditation
 - Validity and accuracy of assessment/overall standard
 - Street works cards/proof of qualification
 - Consistency of training levels
 - Recognition of qualifications issued in other countries
 - Continuous improvement and attracting new entrants
