




Scottish Road Works Commissioner

- Compliance Notices


Authorised Persons



- Commissioner employed staff
- NOT Roads Authority inspectors
- Scope of powers
 - Enter premises and sites
 - Require that information is provided
 - Take copies or possession of information
 - Examine and/or test equipment
- Authorised Officers Code of Conduct
