Why UPRNs and USRNs are useful

- They are unique
- They are high quality
- They are authoritative
- So, they can act as a 'golden key':

Link to other data in the council

• Fewer errors when exchanging data

 \circ Fewer errors when communicating about locations



Benefits to your council

- Increased efficiency of land charges system in <u>Tower Hamlets</u> council:
 - \circ Saved £100,000 from increased efficiencies
 - $_{\odot}$ Saved more than 1,000 staff hours over a year
- Efficiencies across the board in <u>Nottingham</u>
 <u>City Council</u>

Return on investment of 6:1 over three-year period

Other <u>case studies</u>



- UPRN now open data, with co-ordinates
- Mandate for central government to use UPRN:
 CQC registered care providers
 - \circ Shared care records
 - VOA valuations of property
 - Energy performance certificates
- USRN is a key element in the <u>National</u> <u>Underground Asset Register</u>
