Which qualifications do we award?

Qualifications for operatives and supervisors, including reassessment

Street Works – operative	Street Works – supervisor
*LA - Location & avoidance of underground apparatus	*LA - Location & avoidance of underground apparatus
*O1 - Signing, lighting and guarding	*S1 - Monitoring signing, lighting and guarding
O2 - Excavation in the highway	S2 - Monitoring excavation in the highway
O3 - Reinstatement and compaction of backfill materials	S3 - Monitoring reinstatement and compaction of backfill materials
O4 - Reinstatement of sub-base and base in non-bituminous materials	S4 - Monitoring reinstatement of sub-base and base in non-bituminous materials
O5 - Reinstatement in cold lay bituminous materials	S5 - Monitoring reinstatement in bituminous materials
O6 - Reinstatement in hot-lay bituminous materials	S6 - Monitoring reinstatement of concrete slabs
O7 - Reinstatement of concrete slabs	S7 - Monitoring reinstatement of modular surfaces, concrete footways
O8 - Reinstatement of modular surfaces, concrete footways

How we maintain high-quality Street Works qualifications

We have a robust approval process to ensure assessment centres/training providers have the required:

- policies and procedures
- training and assessment facilities
- resources and equipment
- qualified and occupationally competent staffing, including:
 - centre administrators/co-ordinators
 - assessors/trainers for each occupational area
 - internal quality assurers.

How we maintain high-quality Street Works qualifications

Thorough quality assurance processes, checks, and External Quality Assurance (EQA) visits to:

- Ensure the integrity of the qualification is upheld.
- Ensure training is delivered to the specified learning outcomes in line with the assessment standards set out by HAUC.
- Ensure the quality of work produced and the feedback provided is meaningful and relevant.
- Ensure the sampling of learner evidence to ensure the learner has demonstrated they have the necessary knowledge, understanding and skills for each certificate they wish to achieve.
- Identify areas of improvement and agreeing actions with the training provider to ensure high quality of training and administration.
- Review internal quality assurance documentation to ensure that the centre's quality assurance processes are robust, including standardisation, CPD and the consistency of assessment between assessors.

Working together across the sector

Working with the Street Works Qualification Register (SWQR)

- Notification of centre approvals
- Reporting learner certification

All awarding organisations work to the same assessment standard set out by HAUC.

We work in collaboration with each other and HAUC on the maintenance and review of the question bank and assessment materials.

Working closely with HAUC and sharing feedback received from assessment centres/training providers.
