



National fraud figures – is it worth it?




Comparison




What is a Fraud Hub?






The NNDR Pilot

- The two main outputs of the service are:
 - report identifying properties which are missing from your rating list
 - workshop to review report and identify which cases you wish to investigate.
- Wychavon Pilot Results
 - 4500 business accounts
 - 165 Properties reviewed in test

50% found in NDR, 30% allocated further investigation 20% not paying = £40k - £250k returns in pilot alone




