

Scorecards Compliance Check Specification v1.1 – July 2014

<u>Introduction</u>

From July 2013, the Performance Scorecards process is being administered by GeoPlace. The process continues to be owned by HAUC UK

Submissions must be made by sending data to the scorecards@geoplace.co.uk where they will be incorporated into the database.

The structure timeframes and basic validation rules are outlined in this document.

If the data fails you will be sent an email and associated document outlining why the data cannot be included in the database.

If the data passes the minimum validation it will be incorporated into the database and a scorecard will be returned to you.

The data will then be analysed to produce both regional and national views of the performance. This data will only be passed to HAUC UK, DfT and individual Highways Authorities

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<u>Validations</u>

Errors

- Correct format (4 digits, 4 digits, 1 digit, 2 digit, 1 digit, 6:2 digits)
- Numbers all positive.
- Primary noticing Authority must be from the valid SWA codes for Local Highways Authorities
- Promoter must be valid form the current SWA Code list
- All dates must be historic (before current date)
- Complete Files. There must be data for each record type. Partial files will not be accepted.

Warnings

- File name is not in the correct format
- Random null fields present. Assumed to by 0 records
