- Issue of presenting new information (exposing new council data) is that it becomes a target for fraud. So there's less appetite for it.
- Datasets that could be useful to share which can all be derived from Priority Objects:
  - Emergency services
  - Nurseries
  - Schools
- Datasets to share:
  - Free parking
  - Open markets
  - Parks & facilities
  - Address frequency (?)
- Sharing positive things that have been done;
  - Derive this from the CRM and expose with geography (e.g. new road line painting)
- Community events to boost engagement (discoverability of events)
- Street lighting
- Deceased animals
- Prioritise datasets that are used – focus on what is used the most. Derived from hits on Hub
- Consultations
- Concerns over data currency. Stripping it back to ensure not all is shared, again, risk.
