

Roundtable 30: Mobilising the workforce – considerations for future adoption of NUAR

After providing NUAR platform demos we talked about facilitating roll out to staff and to contractors and how access must be controlled yet encouraged. As we approach the lifting of the MVP (minimum viable product) banner, it was good to hear that asset owners would be more open to building NUAR in to their existing processes to enhance data sharing from the platform.

Factors to consider:

- access to 5g in remote areas of work could mean that pre-prepared job packs would still be essential
- embracing a culture of change and learning new skills could present a barrier to adoption in some organisations and the NUAR team would be providing a range of tools to support asset owners and new users.

Additionally

- we talked about notifications of access and of observations recorded in the field
- there was an aspiration to build NUAR into the whole project planning and execution – holding NUAR data and permit conditions in one location for ease of access.
