- Public rights of way confusing. For street works purposes, line needs to be where the path actually physically is, not where it is claimed to be on the definitive map
- Need more guidance on traffic sensors. What is underground is what counts, not what is at the surface.

# Prompt Q3: How can we make the DEC more user friendly? Would a Wiki type document be better? Do you have examples we could incorporate?

- Would like to have introductory sessions to the DEC so that people can use it better, separate form the general NSG introductory training. Say 1 hour.
- Do we need level 1, 2 and 3 diagrams now that everyone is level 3?
