- 8 years since the tragedy
- Many tall buildings still not safe

Fire & Rescue Services, NFCC, MHCLG, HSE/BSR

Where are they?

- UPRN is key to locating and remediating buildings
- Accurate addressing
- Complete classifications

Planning Applications

- Fire & Rescue Services are consultees
- Safety must be built in by design

The ask...

- Early creation of the UPRN
- Cross Reference matching through to Building Control
- Parent UPRNs and why they matter
- Complete classifications




In reality
